




# Fate Story— Residents of Doddamara Road

Panchayat, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore Urban

## Our Fate Story:

We are residents of Doddamara road, Off:Central Jail road, this is an important connectivity between Hosur Road & Sarjapur Road. This area has seen a very good development over the past few years with many new housing societies /school. However it ***lacks basic civic amenities***. Daily this road is used by thousands of residents, school buses, unfortunately this area has zero infrastructure development.



This area is missing the basic need of civilians that are drainage, road, and disposal of garbage. This area do not have a proper drainage system connecting to water body.



Due to which the water logs on the road, which has completely damaged the road. This area has not seen a proper road tarring since several years and not fit for commuting.



Things are worsened without proper garbage disposal system that increases Pig & Dog Menace

We have given several requests, officials visit, but no action has been taken

## Our Fate Story:



To make things even worse, BWSSB since last 3+ years have occupied this road to lay Cauvery stage 5 pipe line.

There is also a a patch of road that is currently in litigation, and BWSSB officials claim it to be the reason for the delay to complete the project.

## Our Basic Request:

**Road & Drainage** – *Covered drainage* on *both sides* from Dodamarra junction till Green Astro cascade and *connect to the nearest water body* along with a *durable road* by officially *clearing all the encroachment*, and *road litigation*

**Garbage Disposal** - *Systematic garbage* disposal system be implemented.

**Streetlights** - *Additional electrical poles* with street light and *maintain* the street lights


**Dogs & Pigs** - solutions to *mitigate stray animal menace* so that the *resident's safety* is ensured.

**CCTV Cameras** - to avoid any *security issues* install a few CCTV cameras also alongside the road.

This is the follow-up on the previous complaint letters/emails and updates:

- Shanti Pura PDO Mr. Basavaraju visited our area on **23rd May 2022**, and he assured connecting the existing drainage line to the nearest water body within 1.5 months. During PDO's visit, One of the residents also spoke to EO Mr. Laxmi Narayan who assured the same.
- We again met Shanthi Pura PDO on **4th June** and submitted a letter with all our grievances, and he assured completion of connecting the existing drainage line to the nearest water body soon, and he also committed to constructing the drain on both sides from Doddamara till Notre Dame School within 3 months after connecting the existing drainage line to the nearest water body. We also requested a temporary solution, and it was declined since they are planning a permanent solution.
- As we mentioned in the previous letters, we further want to highlight the entire stretch from Doddamara to Notre Dame has lots of potholes and the road condition is in a very poor state. It is very dangerous and **accident-prone**, and several motorists have already fallen on this stretch.

We urge Panchayat:

- I. To either make this road at least motorable
- II. or have the BWSSB maintain the road in motorable condition since the condition of the road deteriorated drastically due to the work BWSSB has taken up.
- III. Or Involve PWD and get the drainage and road work done on this entire stretch.

Based on the above commitments: By **July 7th, 2022**, the existing drainage line work will start and will be connected to the nearest water body by **July 17th 2022**. We are happy with this assurance and ready to wait however we do not have any action Plan/Work order to support this assurance, nor do we have any written commitment as we requested in our last letter.

Please take this as a high priority, roads are in very bad condition as the water is flowing on the road.

We request you to acknowledge the letter and provide us with the **written commitment** with **timelines** to connect the existing drainage line to the nearest water body.

There are several housing societies, independent houses, shops, and schools, and thousands of commuters are daily facing the issues. As a resident of Doddamara we are having the following unresolved issues:

1. There is no proper drainage system that has damaged the road and makes it impossible to commute due to overflow or the water stagnates will spread the contagious disease. That poses a health and physical safety concern.
2. This stretch has not seen a proper Tarmac for more than 10 years. That poses a safety concern.
3. The garbage has piled up and no proper garbage cleaning activities. That poses a cleanliness and health concern.
4. Several areas in this stretch do not have street light poles or streetlights, which poses a security concern
5. Stray animals menace, and no efforts to control them or shift them to the proper shelters. That poses safety concerns
6. No CCTVs to control the criminal activities, which poses a security concern
7. We further request to stop the movement of heavy vehicles to avoid further damage to the road and avoid any accidents.


Respected Sir,

On Behalf of more than 10,000 Residents residing alongside Doddamara road which includes various independent houses, commercial shops, and around 12-15 large societies stays in this locality. We haven't seen any development in this area since the last 8-9 years and moreover, the condition of the area is becoming worse. Below are the few key issues for which we have been pleading to all possible authorities but nothing has worked out.

- Road & Drainage** – We have a pathetic road in our area and due to lack of drainage facility it is becoming worse especially in rainy seasons. So please help to build a good road & drainage facility for at least emergency transportation of Ambulance, Fire engine, and school buses. Between Doddamara Junction to our society there are a lot of places where the road is very narrow so please check if any encroachment has been done and the same can be removed.
- Garbage Disposal** – Garbage is being dumped all over this area which has a high risk of spreading diseases. There is no arrangement of daily garbage pickup from individual houses or societies.
- Street Lights** – There are many places where it gets pitch dark due to no electricity poles (Especially from Pioneer Residency to Astro Green) and street light availability and a lot of places where the street lights are not working.
- Dogs & Pigs** – Our area is filled with too many dogs & pigs and this is a big issue because they get very aggressive sometimes and either attack each other or attack residents. Kindly help us with some solutions so that the resident's safety is ensured.
- CCTV Cameras** – We have been witnessing a lot of security issues in this area so request you to please install a few CCTV cameras also alongside the road.





Respected Sir,

We are a residential apartment of 490 flats and more than 1600+ people reside in our society. We are raising this complaint on behalf of our apartment, as well as neighboring societies & residents (Around 10,000 residents) and requesting Panchayath to take our below request

1. **Public Dustbin & daily garbage pick up** - There is no public dustbin available in our area and hence people are bound to throw garbage on the road which has a high risk of spreading diseases. So please provide us with at least 2 sets of public dustbins at some reasonable distances (with Wet & Dry segregation) and arrange for daily garbage pickup from public dustbins and individual houses

2. **Street Lights & CCTV Cameras** - We have already shared the video & images of wherever street lights are not available from Doddamara junction to Astro Green Cascade. There are many places where it gets pitch dark due to no electricity poles and street light availability and a lot of places where the street lights are not working. So please arrange to provide at least 15 new electricity poles with street lights and replace the street lights wherever it's not functional. We have been witnessing a lot of security issues in this area so request you to please install 10 CCTV cameras also alongside the road



3. **Road & Drainage** - We have a pathetic road in our area and due to lack of drainage facility it is becoming worse especially in rainy seasons. So please help to build a good road & drainage facility for at least emergency transportation of Ambulance, Fire engine and school buses. Between Doddamara Junction to our society there are a lot of places where the road is very narrow so please check if any encroachment has been done and the same can be removed.


We residents would like to thank you for your visit yesterday to our layout and for the inspection of layout and hearing our concerns regarding the garbage issue.

We would like to bring to your attention that approach road towards our apartment i.e. from Central Jail road towards Primus School is in very state bad due to the following reason:


